WINEMAKER'S INSIGHT	Showcasing the finest fruit of our Hironnelle Estate vineyard in the renowned Stags Leap District, the 2021 Yettalil opens with expressive aromas of black cherry, cassis, fresh thyme, and spice. On the palate, lively acidity and polished tannins are joined by complex notes of dark chocolate, black tea, raspberry, and sweet tobacco.
HARVEST	The 2021 growing season began with below-average rainfall and mild temperatures throughout spring and summer. A lasting drought reduced our overall crop size, but the effects held a silver lining. The resulting low fruit yields contributed to concentrated flavors in each cluster of grapes, enabling us to create elegant wines with exceptional balance and complexity.
HISTORY	"Yettalil represents the 50-year history of our Stags Leap District vineyard in a single bottle. It brings to life the vineyard we planted in 1972 while using the mindset of my grandmother, Henrietta, for whom the wine is named. My grandmother was always thinking of the next generation and planning for the future. My grandfather lovingly called her Little Yetta, which we turned into Yettalil. We have been carefully cultivating the vineyard since 1972, learning what grapes grow best where, with ideal row direction, trellising and clone. We've taken this knowledge and passion to craft this Cabernet-based wine that demonstrates the best of Clos du Val today." – Olav Goelet, third-generation owner
