WINEMAKER'S Tasting Notes	Fresh aromas of cranberry, sage, truffle, and a hint of rose petal leap from the glass in this vibrant yet complex Cabernet Franc. The palate is soft and well-rounded with lively acidity, silky tannins, and lingering flavors of boysenberry, plum, and black tea.
HARVEST	The 2022 growing season began with moderately low rainfall and mild temperatures throughout spring and summer. The weather warmed up in August and Napa Valley had a early September heat wave that was, thankfully, followed by a few days of refreshing rainfall that quickly replenished our vines. The fruit was able to slowly mature into late October, producing elegant wines with soft tannins and rich, concentrated flavors.
