WINEMAKER'S Tasting notes	A beautiful reflection of our Stags Leap District terroir, this estate-grown Cabernet Sauvignon is rich and expressive with a concentrated nose of raspberry, clove and black pepper. On the palate, the wine is powerful yet fresh and elegant with a core of vibrant acidity and polished tannins. Bold flavors of blackberry, dark chocolate, and cassis are followed by a long, smooth finish.
HARVEST	The 2022 growing season began with moderately low rainfall and mild temperatures throughout spring and summer. The weather warmed up in August and Napa Valley had a early September heat wave that was, thankfully, followed by a few days of refreshing rainfall that quickly replenished our vines. The fruit was able to slowly mature into late October, producing elegant wines with soft tannins and rich, concentrated flavors.
