1985 RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

STAGS LEAP DISTRICT, NAPA VALLEY

COMPOSITION: 93% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Merlot

AGING: 28 months in French Oak

BOTTLED: January 1988

HARVEST NOTES: The long cool growing season of 1985 resulted in one of the finest vintages in Clos du Val history. The slow ripening process allowed the fruit to reach optimal ripeness with balanced acidity and firm structure.



1994 RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

NAPA VALLEY

COMPOSITION: 94.5% Cabernet Sauvignon, 3.5% Merlot, 2% Cabernet Franc

AGING: 23 months in French Oak

BOTTLED: December 1996

HARVEST NOTES: An unusually cool spring resulted in a delayed bud break and the cool weather continued throughout the summer. The crop ripened slowly and beautifully. The mild growing season and prolonged hangtime produced rich wines of great complexity and depth of flavor.



2001 RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

STAGS LEAP DISTRICT, NAPA VALLEY

COMPOSITION: 76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Cabernet Franc, 6% Merlot

AGING: 20 months in 75% New French Oak

BOTTLED: August 2003

HARVEST NOTES: 2001 was marked as one of the earliest harvests in our winery's history due to an unusually warm temperatures in May and June. July was much cooler than normal, allowing the grapes to ripen evenly and reach full maturity with longer hang-time than was originally expected.



2015 HIRONDELLE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

STAGS LEAP DISTRICT, NAPA VALLEY

COMPOSITION: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

AGING: 21 months in 100% New French Oak

BOTTLED: November 2017

HARVEST NOTES: In winter months, a series of rains contributed to significant shatter (the destruction of grapes during the flowering stage). The resulting low fruit yields contributed to concentrated flavors in each cluster of grapes, enabling us to create some of the most concentrated wines we have produced in many years.



2018 ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

NAPA VALLEY

COMPOSITION: 80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12% Merlot, 7% Petit Verdot, 1% Malbec

AGING: 19 months in 58% New Oak

BOTTLED: June 2020

HARVEST NOTES: 2018 was a mild year with average temperatures below normal, providing a warm and extended growing season. The fruit was able to naturally mature all the way to November in some blocks, resulting in rich and beautifully balanced wines.
